

Revised Packing List 2004

Most of the items listed below are part of your initial basic training issue. It is not required for these items to be new; however, they must be serviceable (free of holes and presentable).

All Patches, Rank, Tabs, Badges etc must be removed from all uniforms and headgear. Only the "Follow Me" patch and US FLAG should be sewn on the uniforms.

Final Notes:

-  The Beret will be authorized for wear while at OCS as per directed by the Cadre.
-  Wait to buy other required items (annotated above) at the Ft Benning Clothing and Sales. This ensures uniformity and that all items will fit the required layout and wall lockers.
-  Be Prepared to purchase a new Class A Uniform and do not sew on your enlisted Rank. If you have purchased the new Class A Uniform, sew on the Officer Piping prior to class. A polyester uniform is best and can be purchased during the course prior to graduation.
-  Bring 25 matching wire hangers (no plastic coated or plastic hangers).
-  There will be a Staff Ride to Andersonville and other social events during the course. You need to bring both khaki shorts and long pants with a dress shirt for these social events. (Short sleeve polo in the summer, appropriate winter attire if in winter [class shirt])
-  Bring laundry soap, 1 box of tissues, boot-shining equipment (large can of Kiwi polish, edge dressing, leather dye, polish applicator, brush, and rags only. **Floor wax, leather luster, etc. are not authorized for shining boots**). **Do not bring these items in glass containers, as glass bottles are prohibited.**
-  If you wear glasses to correct your vision, bring 2 pair of military issue glasses of current prescription and a set of protective mask inserts. Contact lenses and civilian eyewear are not authorized until Senior Phase privileges are granted.
-  The only authorized road guard vest must be of the type that is used at FT Benning for trainees no other vest is authorized. Wait to buy the vest at the FT Benning clothing sales. Stencil your last name on the center strip of your road guard vest front and back prior to signing in at OCS.
-  You will need to purchase a Name Stencil from the FT Benning Clothing and Sales prior to signing in to OCS.
-  Bring \$200-\$250 in Cash or Check for class dues. This is the average amount that the class will need per officer candidate to pay for the Formals and other required class functions. These costs are determined by the class' student council and vary from class to class. This amount will vary depending on each class but this is a good guide to help you financially prepare for OCS.
-  Remember if you have ANY questions please check out the [Message Boards](#) located at the official OCS military we site. There are other web sites but the FT Benning OCS web site is the only one that will provide you with accurate information.
-  Cosmetics, perfumes, colognes, fragranced lotions, soaps, and hair care products are not authorized for wear or use until Senior Phase privileges are granted. All items not listed are hindrances. If there are items in question

that may be authorized but not listed; they can be purchased locally once the list is approved by your commander.
